### Shebab's Smile

Shebab came to our clinic in desperate need of dental care. His x-ray tells the story. Shebab's adult teeth were coming in on top of his baby teeth, and all those double teeth were full of decay. Shebab was very sad when he first came in for an extraction. Our volunteer dentists, Dr. Garret Bush with AEGD and dental assistant Emily Bourke, soon won him over and started working on Shebab's smile. Good Shepherd Clinic was able to provide Shebab with the care he needed. We extracted his baby teeth, cleaned up the decay, sealed his permanent teeth, and provided fillings. All of this work would have cost his family \$3,000, money they did not have on their limited income. Thanks to your generosity, Shebab now has the smile God intended for him to have.

For the 400,000 plus Oklahomans with no insurance, Good Shepherd Clinic stands in the gap to meet essential medical and dental needs. We served 2,113 dental patients in 2017 and have seen 1,012 so far in 2018. Our mission is to give people just like Shebab joyful and healthy smiles.
